

2024 SOMA Impact Report

Psalm 78:4: "We will tell them about his strength, and about the great things that he has done; we will tell about his power and the miracles he has done"

Numbers

In 2024, SOMA led three missions and co-led a fourth: three in Tanzania, and one in Mozambique. Seventeen people answered God's call to serve missionally with SOMA, and for seven of those people, it was their first SOMA mission. During those 4 missions, SOMA taught, ministered to, encouraged, and prayed for more than 2000 people. The best news is that more than 1000 came to faith in Christ Jesus and Hundreds and hundreds experienced Him in special and/or healing ways.

Mission Testimony

2024 was a year of collaborative missions. We teamed up with the Christian Renewal Association (CRA) to lead a "beta test" for a children's' trauma healing ministry. More than 100 kids excepted Jesus as their "Forever Friend" and several gave testimonies of inner or physical healing: "Jesus took me from a bad place in life to a good place in life.", "Jesus healed my eye.", and "Jesus cleaned my heart." A subsequent mission to the same diocese was requested to plant a children's inner healing ministry. Several Tanzanian's were trained and then supported by the SOMA team as they rolled-out the ministry at a kids camp to 2,143 children. Over 1000 kids came to faith in Christ. They understood forgiveness and were able to forgive those who caused trauma in their lives. When describing the mission, Bishop John Lupaa said, "It was powerful...lots of people (children) encountered Jesus Christ in a very unique way."

By divine providence, SOMA and the Diocese of Fort Worth found themselves on a shared journey to send a mission to the Diocese of Zambezia, Mozambique. We combined human and financial resources for ministry to 45 clergy, lay leaders, and clergy spouses. The mission's purpose was to impart orthodox theological teaching and to educate participants about the Holy Spirit and His vital role in life and ministry. "Most evenings were spent praying for people lined up in number—nobody would leave. Each proceeding night seemed longer than the previous one as word went around that people were being healed." -Fr. John Kalimi, Diocese of Fort Worth
