St. Ambrose Diocesan Choir

Creation and organization of the “St. Ambrose Diocesan Choir” is in progress! The Choir will be available to the Diocese of Fort Worth and its parishes and missions for use in services throughout the year. The Choir will be a voluntary organization that seeks to maintain a high level of excellence in music and worship. The number of choristers participating in a given service or event may vary depending upon the type of service or event, and directors and organists may also vary for different locations and services.

Purpose: To provide an organized choir that seeks to:

- Serve as the Choir for Diocesan liturgies and similar events
- Prepare special musical services to be offered to congregations in the Diocese, such as evensong, lessons & carols, etc.
- Present an ensemble of high musical standards
- Represent in its membership, a variety of congregations in the Diocese

Expectations of membership:

- Members must be committed to attending ALL rehearsals for a designated service (Only 1 absence will be permitted in preparation for a service or event)
- Absences should be communicated to the Director in advance
- Maintain a professional attitude in rehearsals and services
- Members must be willing and able to prepare the designated music outside of rehearsals so that rehearsals are not spent learning pitches and rhythm.
- Members must take care of music scores used for services (scores will be provided and should be returned in good condition)
