

What's Happening in Sunday School?


The dominant theme in today's lessons is a contrast between obedience and disobedience. In our text from Genesis we see the account of man's first disobedience - how Eve was tempted and Adam fell. St. Paul then gives us a theological exposition of the result of this disobedience, how it brought death into the world, and the subsequent need for a perfectly obedient man - our Lord Jesus Christ, the New Adam - to correct this fault. Finally, we see in the Holy Gospel the obedience of Christ to His Father in his rejection of Satan's temptations. On a practical level, the psalm helps to bring home for us our own return to obedience - which leads to joy and salvation - through humble penitence, and the renewing of our souls by the Holy Ghost.
